



2009 FROM BEER BOTTLES TO ICE CORE RESEARCH


900-1000 GREENLAND'S WARM PAST Which people settled in South Greenland around the year 1000? How does one know that Greenland was warmer at that time?







30,000 BCE ASHES UNVEIL DATING OF STONE AGE TOOLS Naples is today a city in Italy. What was Naples in the Stone Age? In the ice cores there are traces of acid rain from volcanic eruptions. What could these traces reveal?
